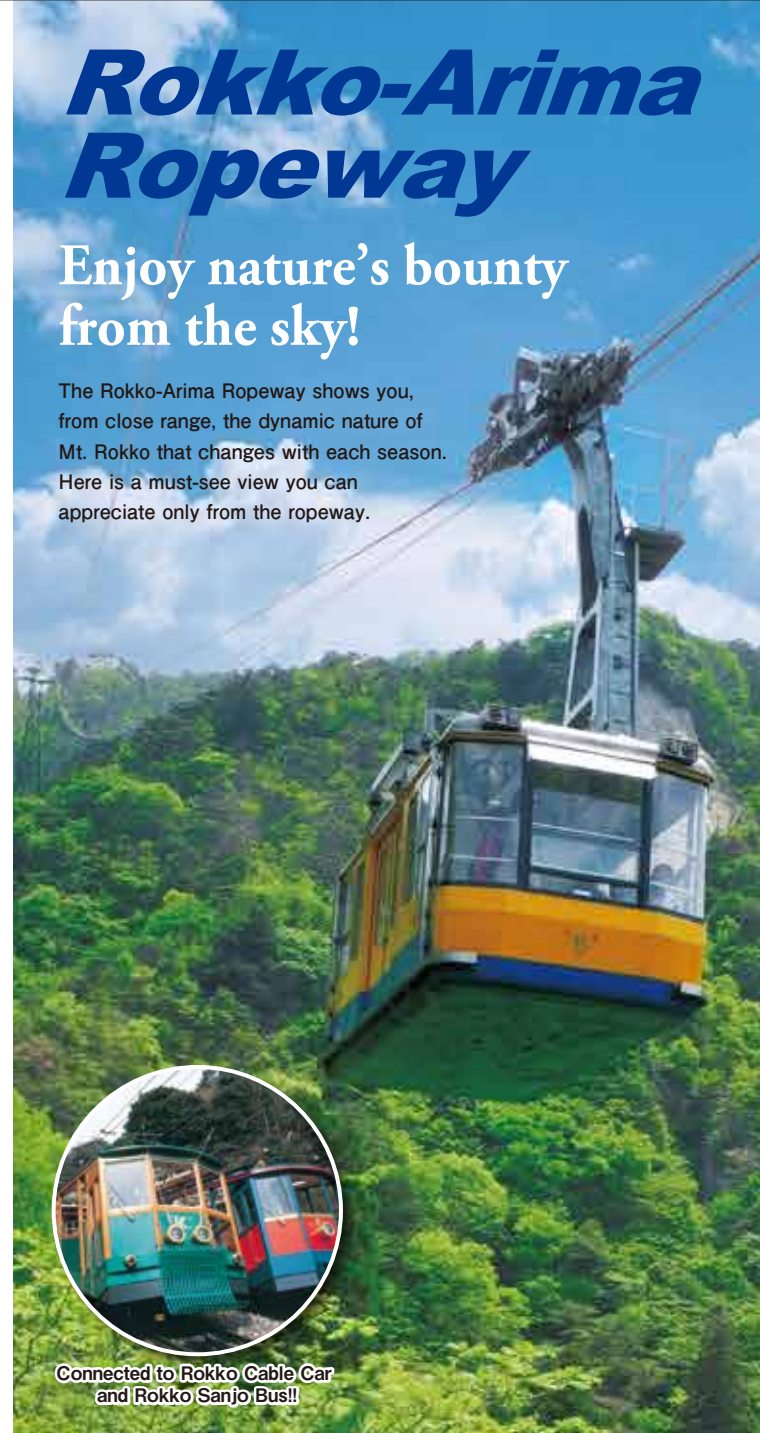

Take a sky-ride through rich greenery to Mt. Rokko

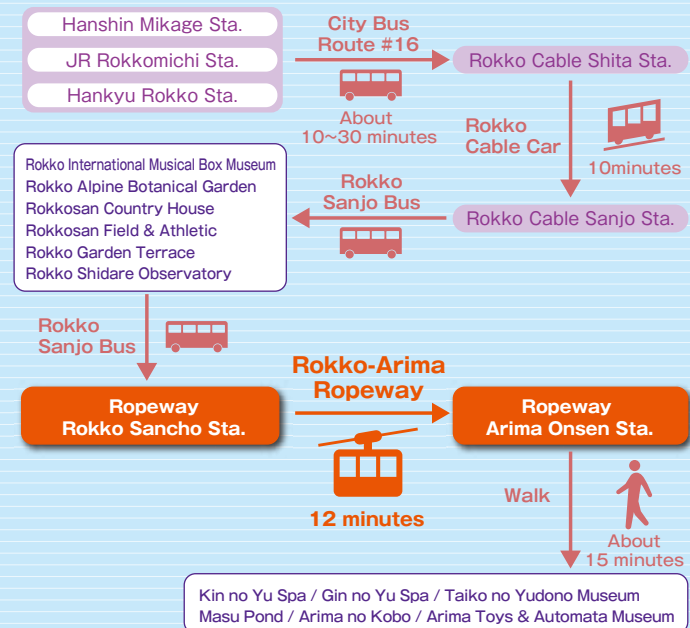

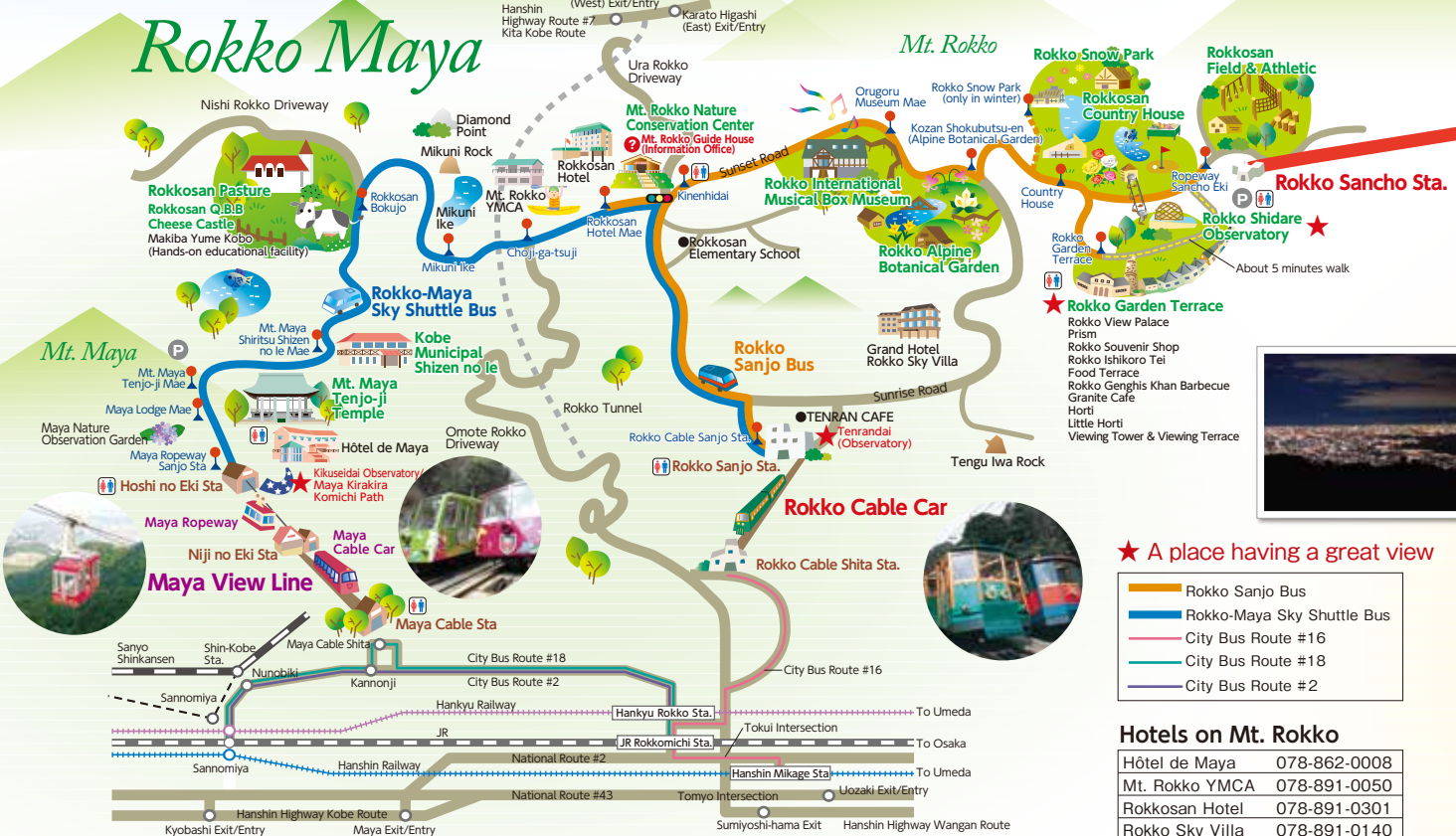


Kin no Yu Spa
